After graduating with an LLB (Honours) degree from the National University of Singapore in 1988 and being called to the Bar in 1989, he founded his own firm in 1995 and is currently the Managing Partner of A Rohim Noor Lila LLP.

Throughout his career, Mr. Abdul Rohim has dedicated himself to public service. He has been a volunteer lawyer for the Legal Aid Bureau since 1990 and was honored with the Outstanding Contribution Award in 2024 for completing over 1,200 cases. Within the legal community, he is a member of the Law Society's Muslim Law Practice Committee.

As a community leader, he has held numerous significant roles. He served as President of the Singapore Malay Chamber from 2009 to 2013, for which he was awarded the Public Service Medal (PBM) in 2012. He also served on the board of Yellow Ribbon Singapore for nine years and was recognized with the Public Service Star (BBM) in 2021 for his contributions. A founding member of Casa Raudha Ltd., a charity for abused women, he was also presented with a MUIS award in 2023.

Mr. Abdul Rohim continues his service as a Board member of LBKM and the Malay Language Learning and Promotion Committee (MLLPC), a mediator at the Parents Maintenance Tribunal, and a member of an advisory committee for the Singapore Prison Service. His extensive record of service is driven by a strong belief in giving back to the community that has supported him throughout his career.

He previously served on the audit and risk management committee from 2012 to 2018.

Between 2015 and 2019, he was appointed as a member of YRSG’s Industry Development Committee where he gave advice on industry trends and developments that might impact YRSG’s business and industrial activities.

He also helped to find possible business opportunities that YRSG could take on to provide the relevant work training for offenders.
